Mr. Saul Zaks (b. 1961, Buenos Aires) is a Danish based Israeli-Argentinian conductor and musician. Mr. Zaks has previously performed in Carnegie Hall, Musikverein in Vienna and Konzerthaus, Berlin, and directed numerous orchestras like "The Jerusalem Kaprizma Ensemble for Contemporary Music" and "the Jerusalem Academy of Music Ensemble for Contemporary Music" to mention a few. This year he released together with Pablo Ziegler (piano & composition), Julio Botti (sax) and The University of Southern Denmark Symphony Orchestra the New Tango Jazz album "Sax to Tango" which has been nominated for a "Latin Grammy Award" for the Best Tango Album 2016.

Hagar Dagan is an Israeli born flute player that even though she has been classically trained has gone on to explore the musical worlds of Jazz, Rock, Ethnic and Pop music. Also Israeli folk songs and Klezmer music as well as Danish composer Carl Nielsen is part of her repertoire. She brings a personal musical journey that contributes to this refreshing and original interchange.

Hagar Dagan (flute) and Saul Zaks (guitar) present a bouquet of Danish, Scandinavian and original musical acts from different genres of music.

This special concert will have the twist of two different artists with two different backgrounds, each of whom brought an innovative new sound to music of their time.
